



Professor Murray Print, PhD is recognized internationally as a leader in Civics and Citizenship Education. He has undertaken research and taught at the University of Sydney since 1989 where he is a full professor and chair of education.

Professor Print has been chief investigator on many research projects including Values, Policy and Civics Education in the Asia-Pacific Region; Civics Education Assessment and Benchmarking; a major project on youth electoral participation in democracy and a Volkswagen Foundation funded project on competences for democratic citizenship in Europe. From 2012-2016 Professor Print has led an Australian Research Council Discovery grant investigating national education goals, schools and building democratic citizens.

In 2011 Professor Print was invited to be Lead Writer and Team Leader for the new Civics and Citizenship Curriculum in the Australian Curriculum, completed in 2015. Professor Print was awarded the Centenary Medal for his contributions to civic education and the community by the Australian Government in 2003.
