



Tom Franklin. He joined as Chief Executive of the Citizenship Foundation in September 2016. His career began in politics – his first job after university was working for a political party, and he then went on to work for the late Rt Hon Robin Cook MP. In his 20s and 30s, he was a counselor in a London borough, including stints as Cabinet Member for Housing and Council Leader. He has held a number of Chief Executive posts, most recently at Think Global, a charity which promotes understanding of global issues like poverty and climate change. Prior to that, he was Chief Executive of the Ramblers, Britain's walking charity, and of Living Streets. Previously, Tom was a member of the Independent Panel set up by the Government to advise on the future of England's forestry; and was an Expert Advisor to the Government's Beacon Council Program.
