



Yuichiro Shimizu. Professor of Japanese Politics and History in the Faculty of Policy Management at Keio University, Japan. His research and teaching focus on Japanese politics from the nation building process, especially human resources policy and governmental institution. His recent book, The Bureaucracy in Modern Japan: from Restoration Bureaucrats to Educated Elites (Tokyo: Chuo Koron Shinsha, 2013; in Japanese), describes the process of nation building in Meiji and Taisho Japan from the view point of making and enhancing national elite. His research is not only historical one, but also comparing Modern and Contemporary Japan, Japan and other countries. He's been to Harvard University as a visiting scholar, to the National Chengchi University in Taiwan as a visiting associate professor; he has written a lot of articles about political attitude in the hopeful youth.
